Dear parents
Overleaf you will find the revision timetable between now and the SATs tests in May. The date in the left column is the earliest date that week that we will go through the answers - please ensure that all work is completed by then and that the books are brought into school. I have planned the whole term so that you can plan ahead for busy times and make sure the work is completed in time. SATs week is May $13^{\text {th }}-$ May $16^{\text {th }} 2019$.

This year there are three different maths books. Children have been given either the Foundation, Standard or Advanced question book based on their predicted attainment at the end of Y6. We will of course still be introducing levels of challenge for all children in maths lessons during school time. There may also be time during the week when children can do some of the revision exercises - so it would be useful if books could be brought into school whenever possible.

This is all revision - it is going over knowledge the children have already been taught. If your child struggles with anything in particular - do not panic - simply mark in the book the concept that is difficult and we will make sure we go over it in class. The revision books act as a useful indicator of whether there are any topics that the class as a whole is unsure of - we will then plan additional lessons to ensure that misconceptions are addressed.

We have included study books for maths and grammar - these are very useful information books to help your child complete the questions. We would like them to be returned to us in June so that we can reuse them for next year.
