Experiences:

- During October, we will be visiting Penzance Fire Station for a very special fire safety talk.



In English we will be:

- Writing an instructional recipe text about how to mix and bake a loaf of bread - similar to the bread that would have been baked by Thomas Farriner in Pudding Lane.
- Writing a persuasive text about whether or not Charles II's actions in the aftermath of the fire were correct.
- Writing a recount of 'The Great Fire of London'.

In maths we will be:

- Focusing on achieving mastery of place value and addition and subtraction by solving problems in context.
- Reading, writing, ordering, comparing and rounding numbers to at least 1,000,000.
- Counting forwards and backwards across positive and negative numbers.
- Mentally adding and subtracting increasingly large numbers.
- Adding and subtracting using formal written methods and using the inverse to check the answers.

In history we will be:

- Explaining why health and hygiene were so poor in 17th century London.
- Understanding and explaining how killer diseases were spread in the 17th century.
- Evaluating the effectiveness of the 17th century cures and remedies for the Plague.



In geography we will be:

- Naming and describing the characteristics of different types of settlements.
- Explaining how a settlement can change over time.
- Describing how and why an area, such as London, has been redeveloped over time.

In art we will be:

- Designing and creating a 17th century inspired building.
- Evaluating the design processes of our 17th century London building.

In computing we will be:

- Researching 17th century London - including disease and building style.
- Researching the actions of Charles II in the aftermath of the Great Fire of London.



In P.E we will be:

- Focusing on our team skills within a game of hockey.
- Dribbling a ball at speed.
- Passing and receiving a ball from another player while moving.
- Finding the best ways to attack and defend in a game of hockey.

In French we will be:

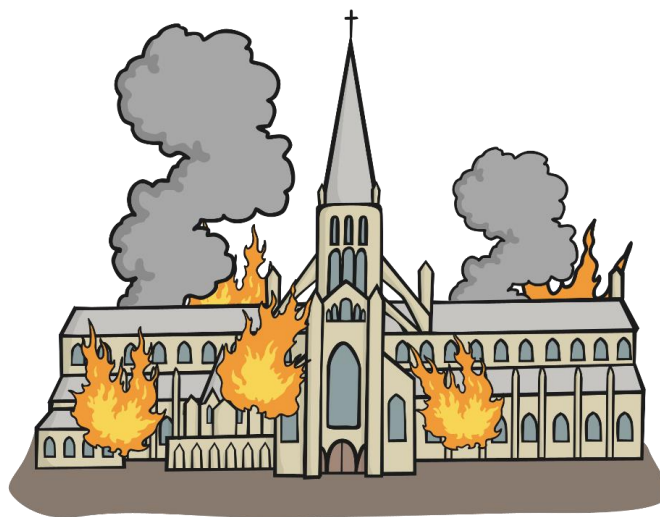
- Focusing on greetings - introducing ourselves and others.
