Choose your homework from the grid below. The peri-ometer shows you the level of challenge.

You need to reach a minimum of ten points to reach your homework target for **each half term**.



6 Points	<p>Write a diary entry (like Samuel Pepys) describing what it must have been like in London during an outbreak of the Plague. What would you have seen and heard?</p>	<p>What do you remember of the Covid epidemic? Ask your family about the effect it had on them and how they felt during the epidemic.</p>	<p>Create a persuasive avert for someone to visit a stretch of coastline somewhere in the World. What might people be able to see or do there? What wildlife would they see?</p>
5 Points	<p>Create a board game based on the Plague. Think Top Trumps for symptoms, or Snakes and Ladders to see whether you will survive! You might even want to devise your own new game.</p>	<p>Create a Google slideshow of the wildlife we could see on our own stretch of local coastline. Where would we see it? How can we look after it?</p>	<p>Make your own Plague Doctor mask. Is your version similar or different to the ones we have learnt about? Why?</p>
4 Points	<p>Visit a local stretch of coastline with your family. What kind of rock formations do you see there? Can you find out how they were made?</p>	<p>Create a poster for people in London in 1665 helping them to avoid catching the Great Plague. What might a poster of the time have advised?</p>	<p>Make a 3D representation of some local coastline. See if the rest of the class can work out where it is!</p>
3 Points	<p>Create a recipe for a cure for the Plague. You may want to design a bottle to keep it in too!</p>	<p>Complete a beach clean and tell us what you found. Anything surprising or unusual? How do you think it got there?</p>	<p>This is a gruesome one – draw a picture of a victim of the Great Plague showing their symptoms.</p>
