6 Points	Draw and label the life cycle of a chicken.	Compare fire safety in 1666 and today. How have things changed and why? Present your findings.	Make a mini book about a plant or animal's life cycle, with diagrams and explanations.
5 Points	Create your own dance moves or exercises to your favourite song.	Build a model of a 1666 street using recycled materials and label the features.	Draw a picture of London in 1666 and label 3 things you see.
4 Points	Practise giving directions from your house to school using compass points.	Make a poster showing how the fire started, spread, and was stopped.	Write a short diary entry imagining you are in London during the Great Fire.
3 Points	Measure the height of each member of your family in cm.	Explain in one sentence what flammable means.	Use a map to find and label London, Pudding Lane, and the River Thames.
