6 Points	Stone Age tools <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Design and make a tool (axe spear, scraper). Label the materials and explain what it was used for. 	Build a Stone Age Shelter <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Build a shelter model using junk materials or natural items. Label its features. 	Stone Age News Report <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pretend you are reporting breaking news (e.g. "Fire Discovered!"). Either write or perform it.
5 Points	Stone Age Stop-Motion Story <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create a short stop-motion animation using toys, drawings or clay. Tell a Stone Age story. 	Stone Age Mask <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create an animal or tribe mask using card or paper. Explain why your tribe wears it. 	Stone Age Diary <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write a diary entry from a Stone Age child. Include feelings and problems faced that day. Make it detailed.
4 Points	Stone Age Speech Bubbles <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Draw a Stone Age scene and add speech bubbles. What might they be saying? 	Jewellery designer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make a necklace or bracelet using string and "beads" (pasta, clay, paper). Explain why Stone Age people wore jewellery. 	Get creative <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Design a simple Stone Age board game where players hunt, gather food and survive. Write 3-4 rules for players to follow.
3 Points	Invent a Stone Age Invention <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Design a new tool that could help survival. Draw, label and explain how it works. 	Stone Age art <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create a Stone Age cave painting using charcoal, crayons or paint. Include animals, hunting scenes or handprints. 	Stone Age Sound Maker <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make a simple instrument using natural or recycled materials. Name your instrument.
