6 Points	Make a model of something linked to the Shang Dynasty – you can use any medium to produce this e.g., clay, paint, scrap materials.	Learn about Chinese food. Find something that you would like to try/eat and make it at home with an adult. Write out the recipe and take photos of your challenge.	Create a fact file, leaflet or PowerPoint about the Shang Dynasty. Include information on hierarchy, living conditions, food, drink, festivals and religious beliefs.
5 Points	Research Ancient Chinese myths about dragons. Write your own short story to include a dragon.	Use a range of sources to find out about a Chinese achievement, invention or innovation that interests you. Record your findings as a list of facts and include a picture or drawing.	Jade jewellery was very popular during the Shang Dynasty reign. Try to create your own Shang inspired jewellery. Try to be as creative as you can with the materials you use to make your jewellery.
4 Points	What is the weather like in China? Make a bar or line chart of the differences in temperature for each month (Jan to Dec). Then write up some interesting facts and findings you can see from your chart.	Print or draw a map of China. Research and map out how much of China was ruled during the Shang Dynasty reign. Try to include major cities and rivers into your map.	The Shang Dynasty achieved a great deal. What would you like to have achieved in the next 10 years? What do you need to do to achieve this? What obstacles will you need to overcome?
3 Points	Can you create a timeline of the Shang Dynasty? Put in as many dates and events as you can find out from our research.	What year were you born in? What Chinese lunar calendar animal is it? What are its characteristics? Do you agree with these? Also do this for members of your family. Present it in a fact sheet.	Write your name in Chinese calligraphy.
