Now summer is coming and the weather is getting better, we have a special BBQ themed lunch on Thursday 19th May, especially for Census Day. This is when the Department for Education (DfE) collects information about each school to help them plan for the future and, most importantly, the data is used to set future school budgets. One of the figures we must report is the number of Reception and Years 1 & 2 children who are having a Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) on this day. The census data is then used to decide how much funding for the year we receive for our hot meals. This means that if your child does not have a meal on Thursday, we will not receive any further funding for the rest of the year. If your child chooses to have a meal on another day, we will have to fund this from our school budget. We do not receive funding for the amount of meals we supply, only the number of meals eaten on the census days each year, so please try our lovely BBQ themed lunch on Thursday!
