

Arty Challenges for KS1 – Years 1 and 2

Drawing

Choose an object /toy from your home to draw, use whatever materials you like working with e.g. pencils, pens, chalk etc. Draw your object/toy different sizes – how big can you draw it? Can you draw it as small as a Duplo block?

Painting

Draw the first letter of your name – make it big. Paint the letter and then the background.



Use as many colours and patterns as you want.

Textiles

Create a fabulous fish collage using different things to create the scales. You could use scraps of fabric, paper or packaging to create an interesting fish. You could even name this new species!



Printing

Have a go printing with leaves and felt pens. Colour over the back of a leaf with felt pens – you could choose one colour or multiple colours. Turn the leaf over, press down carefully on each part of the leaf, lift up and you will have created a leaf print. Why not try creating a pattern with the leaf prints you make!

Sculpture

Create a wrapped sculpture! Use scraps of paper, fabric and threads/string/wool.



Pick an object to wrap fabric/paper around, can you keep it in place with wool? This activity is great for working your hand muscles and practising tying knots!

Artist Related
