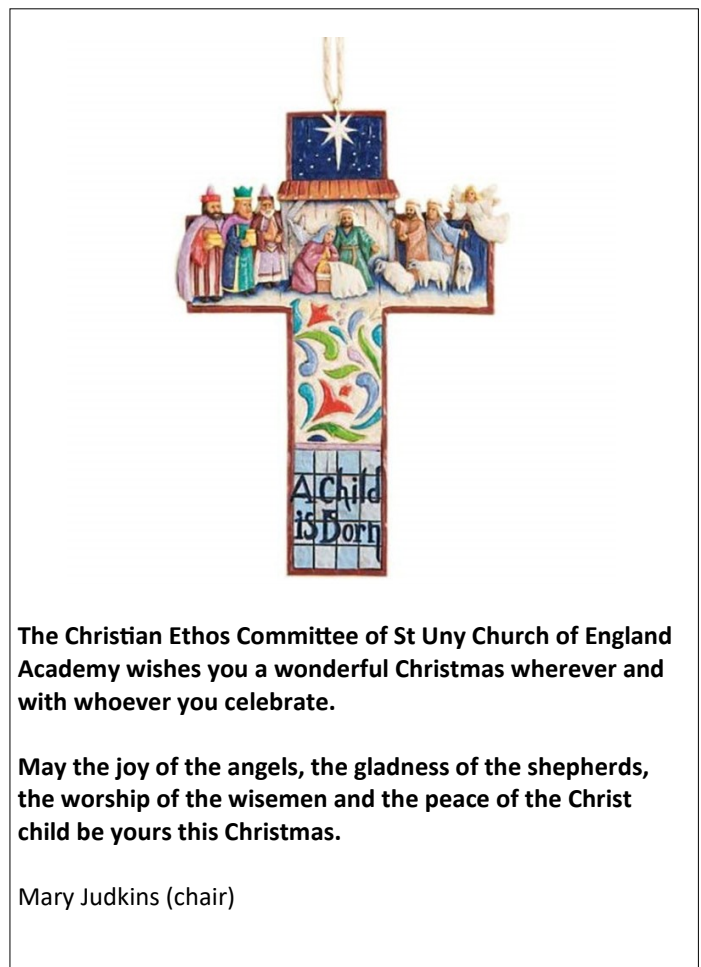


THIS WEEK'S SHINING STARS!
