Demonstrate an understanding of what is read to them, by retelling a narrative in their own words. Recognise Set 2 and Set 3 sounds, both in and out of words. Read aloud simple sentences and books that are consistent with their phonic knowledge, including some common exception words.

Mathematics

We will be learning to:

Verbally count beyond 20. Have a deep understanding of numbers to 10, including the composition of each number. Compare quantities up to 10. Automatically recall some number bonds to 10, including double facts. Recognise and describe 3D shapes.

- The natural world around us and contrasting environments
- Life in St. Ives and life in other countries.
