

# EYFS World Book Day Activities

## Activity 1

### WE'RE GOING ON A BOOK HUNT!



Can you find/name a book with each of the following in - a witch, a tiger, a pirate, a bear, a princess, a giant, a wolf, a king.  
e.g. a giant could be found in Jack and the Beanstalk, The Smartest Giant in Town.

You could have a go writing or drawing the books you find or can think of!

## Activity 2

### BOOK REVIEW

Pick a favourite book.

Draw a picture of your favourite part in the story and write a sentence about why you like the book.



## Activity 3

### RETELL A STORY

Think of a story you like and find toys or objects that might help you to retell it. Act out the story with the toys/objects. If you can't find any toys that could act in your story, try drawing them or retelling the story using the pictures in the book!



## Activity 4

### MAKE A BOOKMARK

Make an interesting and fun bookmark for yourself or someone else to use when reading. You could draw pictures, cut out pictures/photographs, add stickers, maybe add a tassel!



## Activity 5

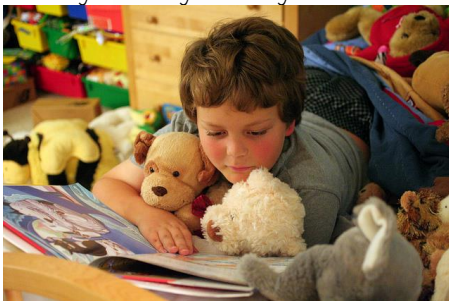
### SHARE A STORY WITH YOUR TOYS

## Activity 6

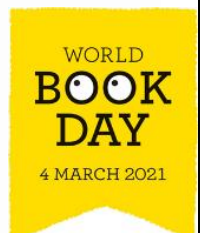
### BAKE SOMETHING BOOK RELATED
