Many of you will not know about the **Christian Ethos Committee** here in St Uny Church of England Academy! So before the end of term here's a bit about us!!

*When St Uny School became an academy Truro Diocese agreed that in doing so the school had to have a Christian Ethos Committee. We are the only Church school in the Aspire Multi Academy Trust and this Christian distinctiveness needed to be maintained - and developed.

* St Uny Academy is still a Church of England school, and we are supported by the diocese, as well as by Aspire.

* We have an Ofsted Inspection but we have a SIAMS inspection (Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools) - which concentrates more on our RE teaching, Collective Worship and how our Christian Ethos is embedded in all that we do. This Inspection wants to find out what difference our Christian Ethos makes to everyone in our school and community.

* Mary Judkins is the chair (she is also a Hub Councillor) and many of you will have heard of her via your children in school! Do ask them what she does....

* Other members of the committee are Pastor Rodney Orr of Fore Street Methodist, Hannah Coles (children, youth and family worker at Fore Street Methodist), Lisa Cook (a Teaching Assistant), Lara Judd (a parent), Jo Osborne (from Aspire), and our own head teacher, plus our Key stage 1 and 2 lead teachers.

* We meet termly for a business meeting, and also at another time for prayer for the school.

* One of our main roles, apart from SIAMS, is pastoral. Everything we deal with is confidential, so if you want to speak to us please do so via the school office.

* You will have seen many of us around school. We do spend a lot of time in school!! We love the pupils and the staff and only wish to serve in any way we can, in order that our school is the best that it can possibly be.

The CEC revisited Our vision statement and we hope you will be familiar with that: **We aspire to be a positive, loving** school where children are equipped to live well with Jesus Christ and with others.

At the same time we updated our Mission Statement: We believe each child is special, unique and loved by God. We provide a broad, balanced and creative education within a stimulating, inclusive and safe environment, inspired by Christian faith and practice.

The pupils and staff all know the 'strap line': **'Let your light shine before others...' from Matthew 5:16**, and try to live it out daily, wherever they may be.
