# UKS2 World Book Day Activities

### Activity 1

#### WORD SEARCH

# Create a word search using key words and characters from a book of your choice.

Pick your book and create a list of words you want to include – it's always good to include words of different lengths. Put your words onto your grid – remember you can write them forwards, backwards or diagonally. Fill in the spaces with other letters. Give your wordsearch and list of words to find, to someone to solve!

Maybe you could get someone to do a wordsearch for you to solve too!

### Activity 2

#### **BOOK REVIEW**

# Choose a book that you have read and write a book review.

A few things to try to include! The title and author.

A few sentences about what the book is about, without spoiling any plots!

Write what you liked/disliked about the book.

Summarize your book – what type of reader might enjoy it? Titles of other similar books.

A score – how do you rate the book? E.g. 4 out of 5 stars.

# Activity 3

### MOVING PICTURE PAGE

# Create a 'moving picture' page for a favourite book.

For this activity you could choose a book that you enjoyed when you

were younger or one that you have read more recently. Use moving parts to help you create an imaginative and interesting page – it may be a pop-up page or have levers to move certain parts of the picture. Remember to write the text on the page that would go alongside your illustration.

# Activity 4

### **ASK AN AUTHOR**



Think of an author that you would like to learn more about! Create a list of questions that you would ask the author.

For example – When did you start writing? How do you think of the ideas for your stories?

### Activity 5

### **READ A STORY**

# Film yourself reading a story.

Choose a book that you enjoy. Select a section of the book that you think others would enjoy too and would entice them in



to wanting to read the whole book themselves!
Read the section through and make sure you are confident with the text (ask for help if you need any!) Set the scene - choose a good place to tell your story and record your reading. You may want to wear a costume or have a prop to help in the delivery of your story.

## Activity 6

### BAKE SOMETHING BOOK RELATED

Have a go baking something related to a book.

It might be...

Harry Potter inspired cupcakes

Alice in Wonderland 'Eat Me'

Dragon biscuits
