Take Away Homework!

Choose your homework from the menu below. the peri-ometer shows you the level of challenge. You need to reach a minimum of ten points to achieve your homework target for the half term!



6 Points	Each weekday practise writing and reading your caterpillar words: I, the, he, she, me, we, be, no, go, was, they, you, my, are.	Each weekday count to 50 and beyond. How high can you go?	Read to your grown-up every day.
5 Points	Make individual number cards for all numerals 0-20. Practise placing the numbers in order. Ask someone else to turn over a number. Which number is missing? Answer other questions relating to the number line eg what is number comes after 16/before 19? etc.	Make your own playdough, follow a simple recipe and talk about the instructions as you follow them.	Make a model using <u>only</u> recycling or other materials from home.
4 Points	Describe a journey around the house or to the park (or take a walk locally). Can you talk about your journey using words such as 'past', 'next to' 'over', 'through' or 'around'. You could draw a map.	Look for objects that rhyme around the house, for example, sock and clock. Write them onto pieces of card (or draw them). You could use them to play snap.	Find some objects around the house. Can you say the word in sounds and blend them together to say the words e.g. c-u-p, cup, b-a-t-h bath, p-e-n, pen.
3 Points	Choose paint, crayons, colouring pencils or felt-tip pens and create your own Spring Artwork.	Design and make an Easter Garden. Take a photo of it to bring in when we return to school.	Ask your grown-up to write the tricky words (or you can) that you are learning on cards and hide them around the room. Take it in turns to find and read the words.
