G7 Nationwide Collective Worship

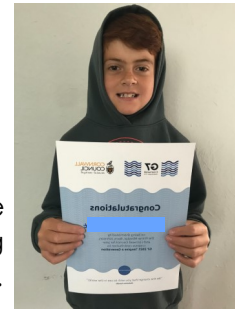

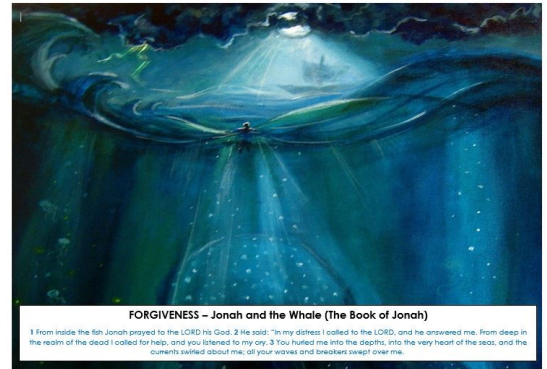
THIS WEEK'S SHINING STARS!

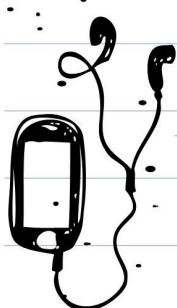
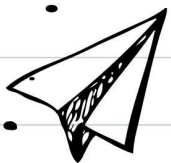
