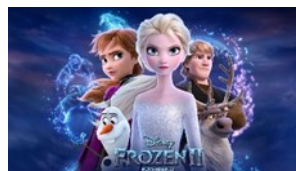
Hockey Update!

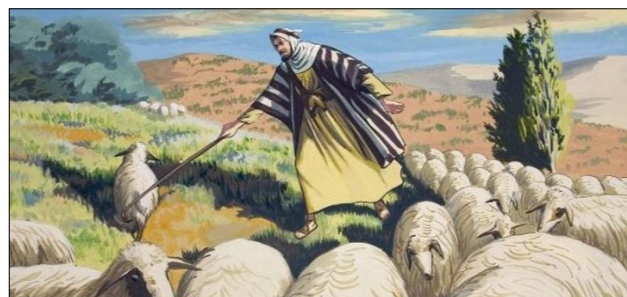
