# **TOPIC: Victorians and Seasonal Changes**

# **Religious Education**

### What is the 'good news' Christians say Jesus brings?

- Tell stories from the Bible and recognise a link with the concept of 'Gospel' or 'good news'.
- Give clear, simple accounts of what Bible texts mean to Christians.
- Recognise that Jesus gives instructions to people about how to behave.
- Give examples of ways in which Christians follow teachings about forgiveness and how they out these beliefs into practise in the Church community.

### Why does Easter matter to Christians?

- Recognise that Incarnation and Salvation are part of a 'big story' of the Bible.
- Tell stories of Holy Week and Easter from the Bible and recognize a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people).
- Give examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' death and resurrection in Church worship at Easter

- show the passing of time in our writing.




