
Understanding of the World: We will be exploring & completing some of the 50 Experiences. We will be identifying some of the key local features, including beach, harbour, cafe, shops, life boat station.

Communication & Language: We will be listening & responding to ideas expressed by others in conversation & discussion We will be linking statements & sticking to the same theme or intention. We will be answering how & why questions relating to our experiences.

Physical Development: While we are out & about we will be learning how to keep safe & healthy. We will be talking about the importance for good health of physical exercise & we will be walking, running & climbing & playing in the great outdoors.

Expressive Art and Design: We will be representing our own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, role-play and stories. We will be thinking creatively about how we can inform Fran about St. Ives and Carbis Bay.

Literacy: We will be listening to stories by authors from St. Ives, Carbis Bay and Cornwall, including Mark Rule (Lorenzo's daddy). We will be composing our own Cornish stories. We will be using our phonic knowledge to read & understand simple sentences in the letters & emails we receive from Fran. We will be writing back to Fran in simple sentences that can be read by her, as well as ourselves.

Maths: During our travels we will be using everyday language to talk about quantities, size, weight & capacity (eg through beach activities and when we are shopping) money (we are bound to come across some food, drink & souveniers!). Position, time, distance (When is it time to go? How much further? Are we there yet?!)
