

Break up for the summer

If your circumstances have changed lately and you think you may be eligible for **Free School Meals**, please apply using the following link: https://www.cornwall.gov.uk/schoolmeals#apply. A child is eligible for Free School Meals if their parent/carer receives any of the following benefits:

- Income Support (IS)
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support
- Universal Credit Your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods

If eligible for Free School Meals, your child will also be eligible for Pupil Premium - additional funding paid to the school to support your child in their learning.
