Activity 1

WORD SEARCH

Create a word search using key words and characters from a book of your choice. Pick your book and create a list of words you want to include – it's always good to include words of different lengths. Put your words onto your grid remember you can write them forwards, backwards or diagonally. Fill in the spaces with other letters. Give your wordsearch and list of words to find, to someone to solve! Maybe you could get someone to do a wordsearch for you to solve too!

Activity 3

CREATE A POTATO BOOK CHARACTER

If you are unable to dress up this year perhaps you could dress up a potato as a book character! Turn a potato into Willy Wonka, Mr Twit, a Mr Man!!

Remember to take a photo!



Activity 5

READ A STORY

Film yourself reading a story.

Choose a book that you enjoy. It might be a picture book or a small section of a chapter book. Find a good place to read – a pile of



cushions, a beanbag, a special reading den. Practise your book/section of story to yourself and if you need help with any words ask someone. When you are feeling comfortable with the text ask someone to record you. You may want to dress up or have some story props to help you deliver your story!

Activity 2

BOOK REVIEW

Choose a book that you have read and write a book review.

A few things to try to include! The title and author. A few sentences about what the book is about, without spoiling any plots! Write what you liked/disliked about the book. Summarize your book – what type of reader might enjoy it? Titles of other similar books. A score – how do you rate the book? E.g. 4 out of 5 stars.

Make a list of your top 10! You could write a list of:

- your top 10 favourite books
- your top 10 favourite fiction books
- your top 10 favourite non-fiction books
 - your top 10 favourite picture books
 - your top 10 favourite chapter books
 - your top 10 favourite authors
