Dear Parents and Carers,

You may have heard the Chief Inspector for Ofsted talking in the news this week about the need for a broad and balanced curriculum and that the inspection framework will change to take a broader view of how well a school meets pupils needs. Academic results will always be important but so will the rich and exciting learning experiences that characterise a good Primary education.

This encourages us as we prepare for our INSET day after half-term to plan our seasonal curriculum. We want to build on the school's artistic reputation and have plans for some exciting experiences over the year. The first of these is an invitation to help children make a variety of poppies for indoor and outdoor artwork as an act of remembrance on Thursday 8th November. You are most welcome to come and join your child's class from 1.30pm to the end of the day.

Mrs Stevens, our art leader, is co-ordinating activities and has some requests for materials.

For the whole school 'Poppy Day' project we need to collect the following materials:

Plastic bottle bottoms - All shapes and sizes. Please cut off the bottoms (adults!) as this is the only part we need and we don't have room in school for hundreds of full sized bottles! Plastic bottle lids. Strips of green plastic e.g. from carrier bags, camouflage sheets, tarpaulin - these will be used for weaving so if you could cut it into strips that would make our job a lot easier.

There will be boxes in the reception area from Monday to put the resources along with samples for you to see. We need enough resources for the whole school, please start collecting now and for the next few weeks so we have enough materials to carry out our project.
