Guinea Pig Names

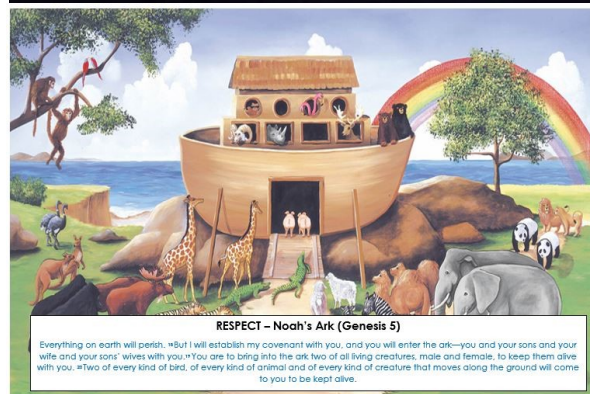
