"Hi, I'm Freya and I'm the Head Girl. My main hobby is horse riding. I wanted to be Head Girl so I can help the school in lots of different ways".


Congratulations to our new Head Boy & Girl, you will all be hearing lots from them about what's going on in school over the next year.
