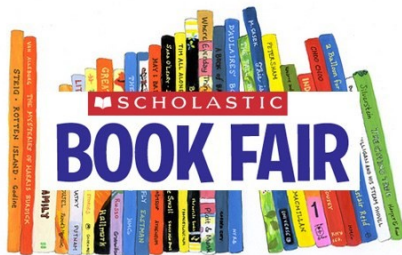
We now have a new section on our website which will have a copy of all letters sent home.
