

COVID-19 REPORTING OVER CHRISTMAS

Important guidance for parents/carers relating to reporting positive cases over the Christmas holidays:

*For the first 6 days after the end of school, if a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **within 48 hours** of being in school, please use the Aspire reporting form at www.aspireacademytrust.org/coronavirus as the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.

*Where a pupil (or staff member) tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms **more than 48 hours** since being in school, the school should **NOT** be contacted (until the first day of the new

term). Parents and carers should instead follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.

*School staff are NOT asked to remain on-call or conduct any contact tracing more than 6 days after the final day of teaching.
