What a busy week we have had at St Uny CE Academy!

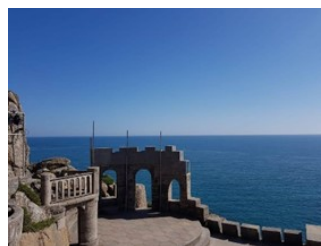


Year 1 and Year 2 had a fabulous time at St Michael's Mount this week, creating fantastic artwork, building sandcastles and exploring the Mount!
