## School Council Update:



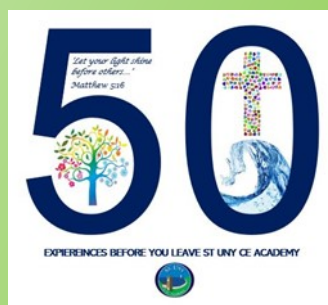
