

Arty Challenges for EYFS

Drawing

Draw a picture of something from in your house or your garden (it may be a flower, leaf or your favourite toy). Make sure you look really carefully and draw everything you can see!

You could use pens, pencils, a writing pencil, chalk or even a biro. You might want to use more than one of these materials!

Painting

Have a go painting with different tools. You might want to draw a picture or just experiment!

You could use sticks, different sized brushes, sponges, fingers.

If you don't have any paints – try mixing mud with water to make a paint or paint with cold tea/coffee!

Textiles

Practise your cutting and sticking skills and make a colour collage.

Use scraps of fabric, paper, ribbon, packaging etc. cut into any shape you choose and stick on a piece of paper or card to make a colourful collage.

Printing

Rubbings – have a go making rubbings from different textured objects and look at the patterns they make. You could find different textures to use for your rubbings indoors or outdoors.



If you wanted an extra challenge you could cut your rubbings out to make a picture!


Sculpture

Decide on something you would like to make a model of – it could be a building, a robot or a vehicle. Use whichever materials you have at home (you might use Lego, boxes, junk, clay, cardboard or play dough).



Artist Related

Have a look at the abstract work of Dutch artist Piet Mondrian – look at his use of the primary colours and lines.
