We will collecting these items again this year on behalf of Janet O'Shea to be sent out to the children of Sierra Leone. If you have anything you would like


to donate, they will be collected from St Uny **every Friday in July**. Please bring them to the school office in a bag.




The FOSUA have registered with easyfundraising and they need your help! easyfundraising is a great website where you can help the Friends Of St Uny Academy raise funds simply by doing your
